The Growing Case for Cannabis

- Growing Global Opportunity** - According to BDSA, the global legal cannabis market is expected to grow to \$55 billion in sales in 2027, with \$43 billion coming from the US, with \$35 billion sourced from the adult-use channel.¹
- Medical Uses** - There are over 100 naturally occurring compounds found in the cannabis plant. The growing adoption of cannabinoids for medical applications such as cancer, mental disorders, chronic pain, and other therapeutic uses is expected to drive revenue growth.²
- Technological and Scientific Innovation** - The increasing number of companies operating legally in the cannabis industry is expected to fuel technological and scientific innovation.

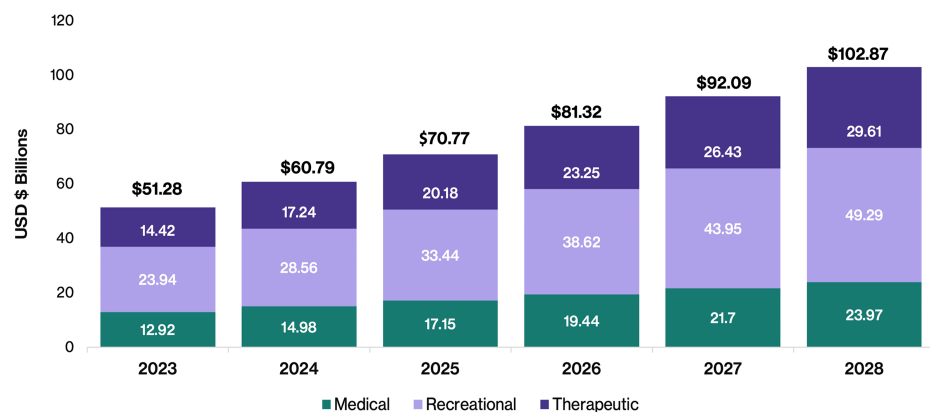

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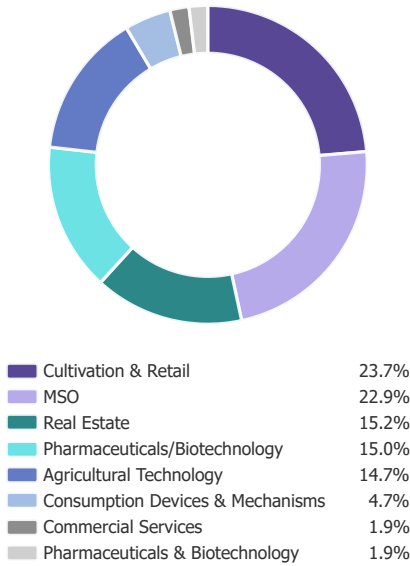

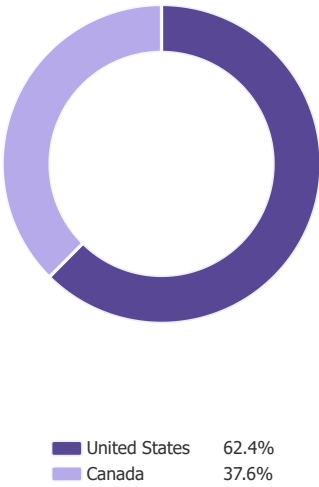
Market Capitalization
