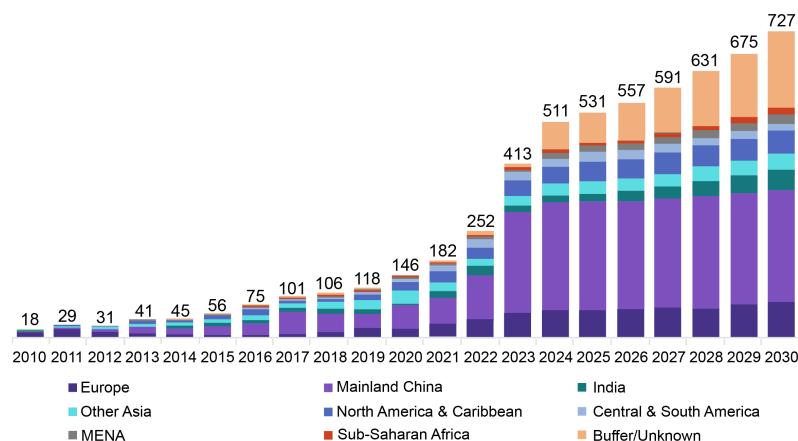

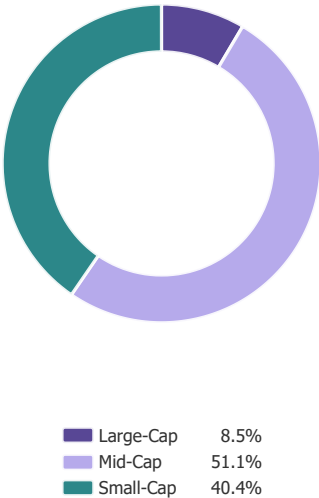

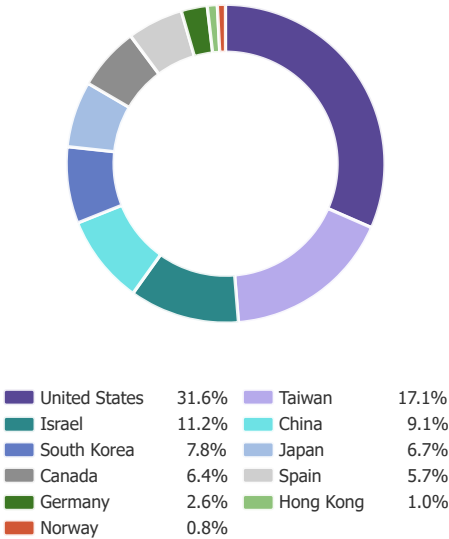
Market Capitalization
